- 3. Form 5 THS students will be responsible for learning the knowledge and skills of making drinks with the professional expert who is working in the field. Students will know more about the job and design the drinks menu for the event day.
- 4. After the event, students will review the experience and reflect what they have learnt, including self-understanding, application of subject knowledge and future planning etc.
